- FAA requested NWS do a demonstration of on-site meteorologists at the New York TRACON
  - Objective: Determine if their presence could help reduce delay and irrecoverable delays
- NWS provided a plan that included Atlanta
- Staffing did not allow for New York to partake
- Plan was to have formal User Suitability Assessment but this was not funded
  - Subjective assessment based on feedback from Ops personnel at A80





### **Atlanta TRACON Weather Operations**

- April 1- June 30
- One met at A80 Monday-Friday with flexible times with anticipated weather
- Laptop for internet access for weather data
- Worked next to the TMC
- Provided scheduled and unscheduled briefs

# **Assessment of Weather Operations**

- Feedback favorable indicating value was having the meteorologist physically present to provide immediate information as opposed to making phone call
- Forecasts "were not perfect" but helped make TM decisions more informed and quicker
  - + Unclear if this reduced delay
- Time to field predictions were biggest benefit
- Use of FAA Decision Support Tools
- Impossible to do an objective assessment with data collected





# **Recommendation Going Forward**

- Delay decision on placing NWS meteorologists at key TRACONs
- Perform demonstration at N90 in 2018 and do a formal User Suitability Assessment
- Have plan in place by January 2018
