NWS initiatives to improve weather information for decision-makers

3-HourlyTAF Amendments

- TAFs for 35 Major Airports
 - Issued every 3 hours

NOAA

- Issued as an amendment
- Issued even when no changes to the forecast
- Provides updated information to the user



Golden Triangle Initiative




- Summer 2009 convection in most congested airspace created massive delays
- FAA asked NWS for services aimed at air traffic decision making for high-impact events
- NWS response: focused weather support to most sensitive area bounded by Chicago, New York, and Atlanta

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Golden Triangle Initiative

- At minimum Chicago, New York, and Atlanta Weather Forecast Offices issue TAFs every 2 hours 16/5 and every 3 hours on weekends
- CWSUs provide tactical decision aids for
 - convection
 - Icing
 - vertical winds for compression
- WFOs and CWSUs collaborate more frequently
 Results in more consistent weather information
 CWSUs monitor FAA strategic planning calls
 Helps to focus on the problem of the day



Golden Triangle Initiative: Early Results


- Enhanced working relationship between all levels of FAA and NWS operations
- Fewer negative comments in traffic management logs
- Work underway to quantify impact of focused support on air traffic decision making

TRACON Gate Forecast


- Forecast for arrival/departure gates identified as "best practice" in 2009 CWSU Site Reviews
- FAA asked NWS to provide a Convective TRACON Gate Forecast based on the one from CWSU Atlanta
 - Focus on the 8 major TRACONs
- Keep Chicago TRACON Forecast as a prototype
 - Generated by WFO convection grids
 - On the path to NextGen



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
